# **ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

The organising authority is Whitstable Yacht Club in conjunction with the Wanderer Class Owners Association (WCOA) and Wayfarer Class Association (UKWA).

## **RULES**

The racing shall be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025 - 2029, the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association (RYA), the appropriate class rules, Canterbury City Council Water Safety Rules, the WCOA and UKWA rules and the Sailing Instructions for this event. In the event of conflict, the event Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

The following amendments shall be made to the WYC Sailing Instructions for the purpose of this event:

2.2. The entry fee will be £30 per boat.

8.1/2. Flag W.

17.1. Varied by Notice of Race: 'Scoring System'.

Participants should also note rule 13.1: Starting Intervals of 3-minute intervals shall be used.

#### **ENTRY & REGISTRATION**

Entries may also be taken on the day at Registration.

#### **PROGRAMME**

The programme is scheduled as follows:

Saturday 28 June 10.30 Registration opens. All participants shall register with WYC.

12.30 Briefing.

The first race Warning Signal will be no earlier than 13.54 hrs on Saturday 28 June.

Saturday 28 June 1400 Race 1

Race 2 back to back to Race 1

Sunday 29 June 1400 Race 3

Race 4 back to back to Race 3

The racing will take place alongside WYC club races.

# **SCORING SYSTEM**

There are 4 races scheduled of which one must be completed to constitute a series. The Low Points Scoring System, RRS A4 will apply. If 4 races are sailed, 3 will count, and if 3 races or less are sailed all results will count - this alters RRS A2 and WYC SI 17.1.

# **COURSES**

Courses will be set in Whitstable Bay, approximately North West of Whitstable Yacht Club. The course configuration will be displayed on the WYC course board. Starts and finishes will either be from the club line or a committee boat. Starts and the starting sequence will be displayed on the WYC course board and at the briefing.

# **RISK STATEMENT**

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event.
- they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore.
- they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.
- their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate.
- the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.
- the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event referred to in the Sailing Instructions and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue; and
- their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £3,000,000 against third party claims.

## SAFETY - SIGNING OUT and SIGNING IN

All competitors shall sign out on the form provided at the veranda railings before launching and shall sign back in on the same form as soon as possible after coming ashore, and certainly WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF THE FINISH OF THE LAST BOAT IN THE LAST RACE OF THE DAY. This procedure is for the safety of competitors and failure to comply may result in disqualification or a £5 fine, which will be donated to the RNLI.

#### **PRIZES**

Prizegiving will take place soon after the final race on Sunday.

Wanderers: WYC engraved tankards for first, second and third places. In addition: The WCOA National trophy, The Gavin Barr trophy, The Runner Up trophy, and other prizes such as the 1<sup>st</sup> All Ladies Boat, 1<sup>st</sup> non spinnaker boat, the "Start as You Mean to Go On" trophy, will be awarded according to the number of entries, at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Wayfarers: WYC engraved tankards for first, second and third places, and other prizes will be awarded according to the number of entries, at the discretion of the Race Committee.

#### ACCOMMODATION AND SOCIAL

Visitors will be met in the harbour adjacent to the RNLI – Boat and trailer parking will be allocated to sections of the beach.

Campervan parking between June 27-30 can be booked via the WYC website.
