

WHITSTABLE YACHT CLUB Tasar UK National Championships and UK Open Championships June 13-15th 2025



IMPORTANT ARRIVAL INFORMATION

When making your way to Whitstable Yacht Club, please do use the club postcode in your SatNavs as it will take you down a very narrow street with no access to the club and limited room to turn.

Instead, use the postcode for Whitstable Harbour CT5 1AB and turn into the Harbour Car Park.

Continue through the car park passing the lifeboat station on your left and some black Fishermen's huts on your right.

Just past the Lifeboats station on your left there is a barrier (highlighted blue below) which will be unlocked for the event. There should be people wearing Yacht Club High Vis to meet you there! Boats should be unhitched here and then walked across the beach to our allocated parking (highlighted red below).

It is important not to leave vehicle parked here for any length of time as it is a very busy area, so once the boat is unhitched you should move your vehicle to a car park or side streets. (If you have camper van parking you can proceed to the end of the West Quay, highlighted yellow below – separate instructions will be given to those that have booked re access to the compound etc)

Parking in Whitstable is famously difficult and expensive. If you do not have parking with your accommodation, free parking is available on some of the side streets a little out of the town centre. Northwood Road, or the side roads off it, are normally a reasonable bet and (depending how far up it you end up) you should allow approx. 10-15 minutes walk back to the club.

Alternatively, there are car parks, The Gorrell Tank being the closest and largest, but at £3.70 per hour or £30 per day you can make your own minds up on that!
